There is beautiful fruit here, showing pure cherry, plum and licorice aromas and flavors highlighted by oak spice and floral notes. This is detailed and elegant, with solid power underneath. The finish echoes fruit and spices. Best from 2014 through 2030.—B.S.

CIGLIUTI

Barbaresco Bricco di Neive Vigne Erte 2007

92 points | \$57 | 750 cases made | Red

Macerated cherry, plum, wild herb, eucalyptus and tobacco aromas and flavors highlight this wild red. Full-bodied and powerful, ending with muscular tannins. Sacrifices finesse for exuberance. Best from 2013 through 2028.—B.S.

93 Cigliuti Barbaresco Vigne Erte 2006 \$57

Alluring aromas of rose, dried cherry and licorice highlight this elegant and expressive Barbaresco. Though firmly structured, this has plenty of sweet fruit to balance the acidity and tannins. The long aftertaste is filled with licorice and spice. Drink now through 2023. 750 cases made.—B.S.
